Who can apply?

- Eurostars is primarily aimed at small and medium-sized enterprises
- Large companies, universities and research institutes may also participate in the project
- An SME always needs to be the project coordinator
- New for Eurostars 3 is that the target group has broadened and gone from targeting "R&D performing SMEs" to "Innovative SMEs"
- The project must be a collaboration between at least two individual partners from at least two Eurostars countries





A typical Eurostars project:

- 3-4 participants
- 2-3 countries
- About 30 months
- Average project cost EUR 1.4 million
- Close to market, industry-driven and bottom-up!
- Largest areas of technology:
 "Electronics, IT and Telecoms Technology" (31 %),
 "Biological Sciences / Technologies" (29 %)
- Largest market area:
 "Medical / Health Related" (33 %)

More participants or larger projects, do not always have to be better!
